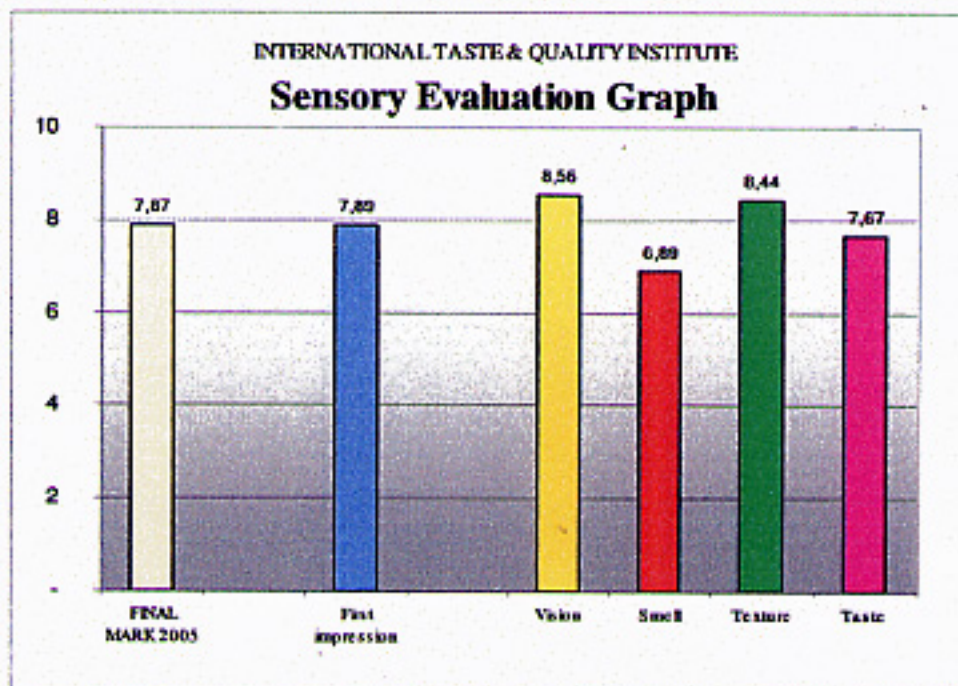

1. Sensory Evaluation Graph




The Final Mark is the result of a weighted average calculation.
